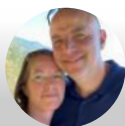

**Anyone serving during a youth event requires participation in our yearly Safety and Risk Management Training as well as completing a Criminal Record Check*

MID-WEEK MINISTRIES

- **Pursuit Leader:** Gather weekly during Pursuit (Tuesdays, 6:00pm - 9:30pm) to build meaningful relationships with youth in grades 7 - 9.
- **Revive Leader:** Gather weekly during Revive (Fridays, 6:00pm - 10:00pm) to build meaningful relationships with youth in grades 10 - 12.
- **Drivers:** Need to be age 25+ with a clean drivers abstract. Drivers are needed weekly for pick-up and drop-off of youth. Drivers are also needed for special events.



OTHER

- **Snacks:** Bake cookies, bars or some other easy to serve snack. 10+ dozen are needed each week for both Pursuit and Revive. We will take baking anytime you are willing to help us out!

KITCHEN MINISTRY

COMMON THREADS MINISTRY

Ministering to Widow and Widowers in our Community

Positions are required once per month from September to June

- **Triad Member:** Leader for planning/organizing committee (3 or more person triad).
- **Head Cook:** Planning, food shopping and executing meal, with the help of the rest of the team (alternating months with other cooks). *Church supplies gift cards, so no out of pocket expenses required for food purchases.*
- **Mid-Afternoon Food Prep:** Afternoon food and drink preparation and arranging buffet and guest tables with tablecloths, place settings and decorations.
- **Dinner Food Serving / Cleanup:** Serving food, busing dishes, washing dishes, food clean-up and table take down.
- **Dishwasher:** Arrive for clean-up.
- **Table Set-Up / Take-Down:** Setting up or taking down buffet tables and guest tables and chairs (Do not have to be there for both)
- **Sound System Set-up / Take-Down:** Setting up and taking down microphone system.
- **Decorator:** Planning and arranging seasonal table decorations.
- **Activity / Music Coordinator:** Scheduling of activities / music.

KITCHEN MINISTRY

Welcome Sunday Dessert Potluck Fellowship after the church service

Positions are required approximately 3 times a year

- **Triad Member:** Leader for planning/organizing committee (3 or more person triad).
- **Setup / Clean-up:** Assemble coffee, tea and water station. Help with clean-up.

FRIENDSHIP COFFEE FELLOWSHIP

Ministry to adults making connections, curbing loneliness, encouraging belonging to community and finding new friendships

Positions are required once a month from September to June in the morning from 9am to 11am

- **Triad Member:** Leader for overseeing membership (3 or more person triad).
- **Beverages:** Make coffee, tea, water and set out for attendees.
- **Table Set-up / Take-down:** Set-up a few tables and chairs and then take down after time.
